11 Markers in Total

City of New London

- Supportive
- No interest in direct participation

Historical Society

- Were not aware of the historical markers at the time we spoke
- No funding available

NPA Community Survey Results

- 74% see the markers as important to Neptune Park's identity.
- 83–84% support using a portion of the contingency fund, with the understanding it will be replenished over time.
- Strong preference for historically accurate designs that match the original traditional look, not modern or “slick” styles.

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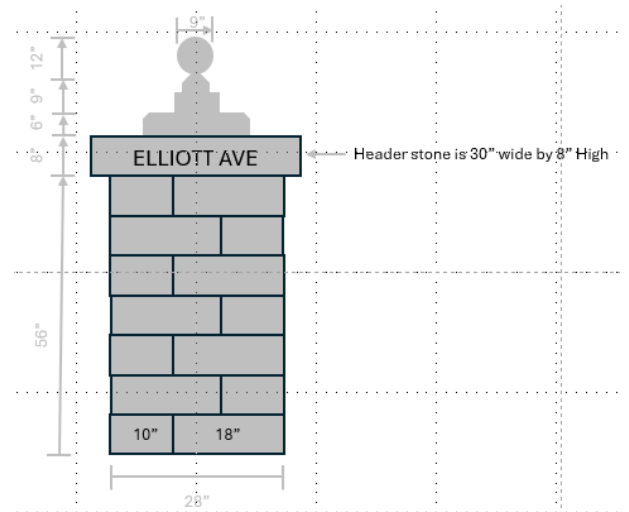
Cost Estimates

Tear Down and Remove All of the Monuments:

\$13,250.00

Replace Each Monument:

- Labor: \$6,900
- Materials: \$6,000 - \$10,995
 - Base: \$3,650.00 - \$5,750
 - Engraved Pillar Cap: \$1,000 - \$2,270
 - Pitched Cap: \$750.00 - \$1,450
 - 10" Finial/Orb: \$350.00 - \$1,525
- Miscellaneous (Freight, etc.): \$250.00
- New Footings: \$1,075.00 - only, if necessary.



Bottomline:

- Approximately \$13,000 per marker without new footing.
- Approximately \$14,000 per marker with new concrete footing.
