TRAFFIC AND PARKING UPDATE

History

At last year's Annual Meeting the NPA Community brought forward concerns regarding **cars driving the wrong way, non-residents parking** within our community, and **cars driving the wrong way down our one-way streets**. In response the NPA BoG established a committee to work with the City of New London to address issues with speeding, one-way traffic and parking.

City of New London

Established a Residential Permit Parking program in June 2015 to help ensure on-street spaces are available for people who live there. The program is run by the New London Parking Authority and LAZ Parking, which manages city parking facilities and on-street permit zones. In existing zones, residents and eligible property owners can apply for registered plate permits for their vehicles; permits are tied to license plates and specific residential areas. The system is designed to protect resident parking, encourage compliance, and deter long-term parking by non-residents on residential streets.

Actions:

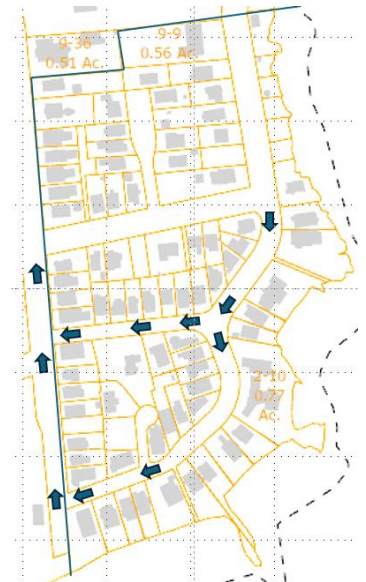
- We met with the city a few times and are in discussions about the following remedies and have an opportunity to influence the City's program and enforcement.

Wrong Way Driving Solutions

- New One Way and Do Not Enter Street Signs have been installed.
- Arrows are to be Painted On Mott, Elliott, & Ocean Avenues.

Resident Parking Solutions

- New Resident Parking Signs have been Installed.
- 2 Resident Parking Passes Per Property
 - **Residential Parking Applications are available online.**
 - Submit application & pick up stickers at Water Street Garage in New London.
 - **Address verification is required.** A Driver's License (Mandatory), A Registration (Mandatory) and ONE of the following: Mortgage/Deed/Lease, Notarized Letter from your Landlord, a Bank Statement, or a Credit Card, Phone, Tax, Cable, Water, Insurance, or Utility Bill **are required.**
 - **Stickers or Hanging Placards** can be moved from car to car.



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- LAZ Parking patrols, checks for permits, and issues citations where needed.
- NPA can request specific patrol days/times.
- \$25 Violations
 - PARKING IN A BUS STOP
 - PARKING MORE THAN TWELVE (12) INCHES FROM THE CURB
 - PARKING ON A SIDEWALK
 - PARKING IN A CROSSWALK
 - PARKING ON THE WRONG SIDE OF THE STREET
 - PARKING IN A “NO PARKING” AREA
 - DOUBLE PARKING
 - PARKING WITHIN TEN (10) FEET OF A CORNER
 - **RESIDENTIAL PARKING ZONE ONLY – PERMIT REQUIRED**
 - PARKING WITHIN TEN (10) FEET OF A FIRE HYDRANT
- \$50 Violations
 - PARKING IN A FIRE LANE \$50.00
 - OBSTRUCTING A DRIVEWAY OR CURB CUT \$50.00
- \$125 Violation
 - VIOLATION OF HANDICAPPED PARKING (STATE PERMIT REQUIRED)

Note parking citation fines double if not paid within fourteen (14) business days.

- Program success depends on good communication and residents helping to reinforce the rules.
